As the exclusive mobile reseller, KVH is the only company licensed to promote the high-powered DirecPC service, accept subscriptions, and activate accounts for mobile customers in the United States.

The DirecPC service is being offered by Bell ExpressVu, a Canadian satellite service provider, through arrangement with Hughes Network Systems. Launched in September 1997, Bell ExpressVu is Canada's fastest growing Direct-to-Home television company, providing the highest quality and most comprehensive satellite services across the country. With more than 800,000 subscribers, Bell ExpressVu is the fifth largest broadcast distributor in Canada. The company is wholly owned by BCE Inc., Canada's largest telecommunications company. Through its subsidiaries and affiliated companies, including wholly owned Bell Canada, BCE provides telecommunications services to 70 percent of Canada's population.
